CLEARING OUT PROCEDURE

Once you are ready to leave, you must pay your ZYC account up to date. Upon receipt of this payment, you will receive a flight plan which needs to be stamped by the following authorities: Please note the office closes @ 12 on a Saturday and the final flight plan (stamped by all authorise as indicated below) needs to be submitted by latest 11:30am

- 1. Zululand Yacht Club
- 2. Zululand Yacht Club TNPA
- 3. Immigration
- 4. Customs
- 5. Boarder Control 076 1286 571 On the 2nd floor, room 28 Tuzi Gazi Building
- 6. Zululand Yacht Club to clear for TNPA

Once all the stamps have been obtained the flight plan will be emailed to Port Control on your behalf by the ZYC offices. You need to obtain a copy of the flight plan before departure with confirmation of clearance.
